- Note from Vickie at National Office on Release Forms. National BPA has received questions concerning whether or not Release Forms must be typed. We specifically indicate on the Individual and Team Entry Forms that they must be typed; however, we do not have that wording on the Release Forms (even though on Page 13 of the ML and S/PS WSAPs it indicates that any handwritten forms, excluding signatures, are not acceptable and will not be awarded specification points). While I know this is a contradiction, it is, in my opinion, unrealistic to ask students to get the Release forms typed, especially when they are out filming and they may not know the person they would like to use in their project. I think it would be difficult, if not possible, to get a form back if we asked the person to type it and then return it to us. I think that in some instances trying to get the form back from classmates could be problematic with the busy schedules everyone has, as well. I do think the handwritten forms must be legible but I am of the opinion that trying to get them typed is extremely difficult.
